This payment is being made to the district for an amount equal to the product of the district's 2020-21 pupil


membership multiplied by the difference between \$1,093 and the district's ESSER Ill formula payment per pupil. 51.4% of the 11T allocation has to be spent on activities to address learning loss by supporting the implementation of evidence-based interventions, 10.3% for the implementation of evidence-based summer enrichment programs and 10.3% for the implementation of evidence-based comprehensive after-school programs.




