

Dansville Middle School Board Report:

Monday, November 9 DMS Student Council visited a Dansville Village Council meeting to obtain permission for an event the club is planning on doing. Students plan to create a design, organize group members, and decorate the light poles at the four corners of downtown Dansville. The Village Council was very excited about this endeavor and hopes we continue to do this in the future. Students will decorate the light poles for the winter holiday this year. The group also reached out to NHS and PALs in the High School as well as the Athletic Boosters.
