

Dansville High School Board Update

- The high school PALS raised funds for every middle and high school student to receive a white Aggie t-shirt for our basketball “black-out” games. The students also took time to have Graffiti Day, where they wrote positive messages or words on each others’ shirts.
- Prevention Specialist at the Eaton RESA, Melea Bullock, shared her expertise with our high school students about social media and youth mental health. Results of a student survey indicated our students found the presentation beneficial and several students have asked for follow-up discussions.
- The National Honor Society partnered with the American Red Cross to sponsor another Blood Drive. Dansville surpassed their goal of 25 pints by collecting 35 pints of blood at the February event.
