

Policy for Bomb Threats or Similar Emergencies

In the event of a bomb threat or similar emergency, the Superintendent or his designee may evacuate the school and conduct the students to a place of safety. School may be dismissed at the discretion of the Superintendent or his designee. If a specific time is known and has passed, and sufficient time remains in the school day to warrant continuation of the school day, classes may resume at the discretion of the Superintendent.

The administration will develop procedures for the handling of such threats and also develop a plan for orderly and safe evacuation of pupils and staff.

The Ingham County Sheriff Department or State Police will be called in all cases of bomb threats. The Ingham Township Fire Department may be called. We acknowledge the authority of emergency responders to determine if/when to evacuate the building.
