

Community and Adult Education

The Board of Education believes that education is a continuous process throughout life and supports the position that the District should cooperate with other community agencies in providing educational, cultural, and recreational opportunities for all of its citizens. The school, in this setting, becomes a force for community service and improvement; and the values the community seeks for children in the regular school program are, thus, available for all residents through the community and/or adult program.

With regard to community education, the Board may provide programs in the evening for the purpose of meeting the vocational, recreational, and cultural interests of the community, when such programs will not interfere with the primary purpose of the school which is K-12 education and is self sustaining and resources are available to the district.
