

Dance Policy

1. There will be a minimum of 12 chaperones with a minimum of two teachers.
2. Dances are primarily for Dansville students. Students attending another school may not attend high school dances without the principal's permission. Students on suspension may not attend. Middle school dances are for Dansville middle school students only.
3. The organization sponsoring the dance will provide a committee of two students to be at the door to positively identify all who wish to enter.
4. The name of each student permitted to enter will be recorded in a dance log along with the exact time. When they leave the exact time of departure will be entered. When parents call we will be able to accurately identify the presence or absence of any student.
5. The admission charge will be made at the door and no one will be allowed in the building to loiter who does not qualify for the dance and has not paid.
6. When a student leaves they will not be permitted to return. Offering to pay again will not qualify you for re-entry.
7. Tables will be provided in the hallways for students to place coats on. Bulky coats and jackets that easily provide for hiding of cans and bottles will not be permitted to enter the gym. Any sponsor may check any student's pockets or purse if they suspect the presence of contraband. Any student refusing to cooperate will be put out immediately.
8. Any student who is disrespectful to any sponsor will be asked to leave immediately.
9. No one will be admitted during the last 60 minutes of any dance.
10. Any student who becomes obscene, threatening, abusive will be punished as follows:
 - A. put out of that dance.
 - B. barred from future dances at administrative discretion
 - C. suspended from all school classes and activities as determined by the principal
11. Any student caught with drugs or alcohol in their possession in violation of the law on school property or at our dance will be reported first to the police and second to their parents.
12. Middle school students will not attend high school dances alone or as a guest and vice versa.
