

Electronic Devices

The Dansville Board of Education is opposed to the surreptitious gathering of data on any student or employee by electronic devices. Any employee or student so engaged is subject to discipline. Any material so gathered shall be deemed unfit for evidence against said employee.

Keeping in mind that the use of an electronic device is a privilege that may be forfeited, the administration shall develop rules for the use of electronic devices by students on school property, including, buses, at after school activities and at school related functions.

Further, the use of electronic devices in the locker rooms, bathrooms or other areas where students have an expectation of privacy will be construed as grounds for reasonable suspicion and a potential attempt to violate the rights of others and may result in confiscation and/or search of the device's contents.

*Cell phone use is prohibited in a lockdown situation as per the County-wide directive procedure.
