

## **Flyer Distribution Policy**

The Dansville Board of Education is committed to assist non-profit/non partisan organizations serve the needs of Dansville School students.

While we support the concept of free speech, the school is not a public forum for all organizations or citizens to promote their particular cause. Any material or activity that would disrupt, or in any manner interfere with, the educational process will be strictly forbidden or promptly removed.

Each building (Elementary School, Middle Schools and High School) will provide a designated space for public posting of materials or announcements. All such postings must have prior written approval of the building principal. All postings will have the date of posting, name and address of the person responsible for the posting. All postings will be for a maximum period of two weeks. Materials exceeding normal paper size (8 ½ x 11) will be discouraged. The organization/person posting the materials will be responsible for the physical posting and for removing same within the above stated time period. Failure to remove the material after the stated time interval may result in denial of further postings.

School employees may make available or hand out materials for internal school organizations and school-affiliated organizations recognized by the Board of Education at the annual organizational meeting. Materials to be handed out will be approved, by the building principal. In addition to the above, the school may hand out materials for organizations that serve a great number of students attending Dansville Schools. The following are named organizations serving Dansville students: DCAA, Boy Scouts, and Girl Scouts, Dansville Youth Center and the Upwards Sports program. For those desiring to be added to the aforementioned list, they may petition Board of Education through the superintendent.
