### **Adequate Yearly Progress**

For 2010-2011, Dansville High School made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in English language arts and mathematics. While we are pleased to have reached this important goal, we are continuously working to improve. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff and our community in this effort.

### **Dual Enrollment and AP Courses**

- Dansville High School had 7.6% of our students Dual Enrolled. These 22 students took a combined total of 57 courses.
- Dansville High School offered four Advanced Placement (AP) courses. 49 of our students (17%) were enrolled. Of these 49 students, 5% received a score of 5; 25% received a score of 4; and 18% received a score of 3, which means 48% of students who took an AP class potentially earned college credit.

Dansville High School is pleased to continue its tradition of quality educators, a challenging curriculum, and outstanding parent involvement. This AER reflects the combined efforts of the staff, parents, and community. All of our stakeholders should be proud of our school's achievements, yet continue to look towards future growth.
