

Locker Inspections and Searches

All students will be assigned a hall locker. Lockers and locks are the property of Dansville Schools and students are not to use their own locks. **Lockers are assigned to students for their convenience; however, because lockers are school property, students have no expectation of privacy when using them.** Each student should safeguard the combination to prevent entry. Lockers should be kept clean and neat both inside and outside. Students are not to keep their belongings in a locker other than the one they are assigned.

All lockers are subject to periodic and routine inspections by school authorities. Lockers may be inspected for specific reasons without student notice or approval. Any item which is illegal, a health hazard, dangerous, or is expressly in violation of board policy will be confiscated. Any student in violation of this policy is subject to discipline or prosecution by school and/or law enforcement authorities.

Lockers should be locked at all times to discourage theft and tampering. Money, jewelry or items of considerable value should not be left in lockers. The school does not assume liability for items lost or stolen. Any problems with the locker should be reported to the office.
