

## **OVER-AFFECTIONATE BEHAVIOR**

The purpose of this policy is to set guidelines for physical relationships. Public displays of over-affection are not acceptable.

Staff members confronting anyone engaged in over-affectionate behavior should take the following step:

Inform the students that their behavior is inappropriate and that you would not expect to see this type of behavior again. The staff member witnessing this behavior would fill out a referral slip which would be filed in the H.S. office. The only display of affection which is acceptable is holding hands.

When the principal receives the referral slip, he will initiate the following steps:

- a. The principal will meet with both students informing them as to the expectations.
- b. Second referral the principal will meet with the students and send written notification to their parents/guardians.
- c. A third referral would result in assignment to a Saturday school.
- d. A fourth violation would require a conference between the principal, student and parent/guardian before the student could return to school.
