

School Clubs and Organizations

Dansville Schools recognizes several clubs or organizations as student groups that are part of Dansville Schools.

Each organization and member must adhere to Board policy and school rules as published in the student handbooks when meeting or engaged in any activity representing the organization.

All fund raising activities must be approved by the building principals and superintendent. All activities other than normal meetings must have prior approval from the building principal.

Requests for financial assistance, for awards, trips, etc., will be accompanied by a detailed list of expenditures and internal criteria for awards. The Dansville "D" will be awarded only for athletics, band and as an Academic Letter. The building principal will approve or deny proposals for awards. No student award will be approved if over \$15.00 in cost per individual.

The treasurer of each organization shall submit expenditure requests to the building principal prior to dispersing any funds. The organization shall not incur any debt not covered with existing funds. Funds for all clubs will be held in the Trust and Agency accounts.

Any new clubs or organization to be formed shall submit their proposal to the building principal. The criteria for recognition is that the clubs should meet a student need, community need and be within the educational mission of Dansville Schools. The building principal has the authority to give school recognition to new clubs or withdraw school recognition for cause, from previously recognized clubs.

Building principals will submit a list of current clubs/organizations, number of students and sponsor's name to the Board of Education annually.

Decisions of the building principal may be appealed to the superintendent and subsequently to the Board of Education.
