- Applicants must meet the following criteria:
 - Be at least 18 years old.
 - Be a citizen of the United States.
 - Have been a resident of the State of Michigan for at least 30 days.
 - Reside within the Dansville Schools district.
 - Be a qualified school elector (registered voter in the school district).

Individuals convicted of a felony involving dishonesty, deceit, fraud, or a breach of public trust within the preceding 20 years (related to their official capacity while holding any elective office or position of employment in local, state, or federal government) are not eligible.
