- Sue Provencal presented her annual Title I Parent Meeting via Zoom this month to an audience of four parents. She always does such quality work with students and with her parent presentations. She is an authority and parents trust her with helping their students make progress...and she delivers! Even though the Zoom format for the meeting was a new twist it did not hinder her at all from explaining her program, how kids qualify or in answering any of the parents' questions.
