



Dansville School District 2025-2026 School of Choice

The application timeline to apply as a School of Choice student
for the 2025-2026 school year is **June 1st-15th**

Eligibility for Schools of Choice

- **Residency:** Dansville School District has approved a limited school-of-choice program for the 2025-2026 school year. Non-resident students eligible to apply for the available openings must reside in a school district located in either the Ingham Intermediate School District (ISD) or in a school district in one of the ISDs contiguous to Ingham County.
- **Transportation:** Parents are responsible for providing transportation to and from school each day.
- **Non-Discrimination:** Dansville School District will accept non-resident students based on a lottery system, without regard to intellect, academic, artistic, athletic, or other ability or talent, mental or physical disability, religion, race, color, national origin, sex, height, weight, or marital status. Dansville School District reserves the right to deny access to a student residing outside the Ingham Intermediate School District if a mutual agreement cannot be reached with the student's home district/ISD related to responsibility for added costs.
- **Discipline:** Students may be removed from consideration if they have been suspended from school in the past two years, if they were ever expelled from school, or if they have been convicted of a felony. We will confirm the information you provided regarding your child's previous discipline with your child's current building principal.

Limited Openings Available in 2025-2026 school year:

The chart below is the number of openings per grade level for the 2025-2026 School Year: Semester 1

For grade levels that more applications are received than advertised slots, the law requires that districts accept students on a lottery basis (except as provided by law regarding suspensions or expulsions). Siblings of current Schools of Choice students receive preference to available slots over new applicants.

Based on resident enrollment over the summer, teacher-pupil ratios, available space, and other relevant criteria, the District may accept more students from the waitlist developed through the lottery.

Application Process

Parents/guardians must submit a completed School of Choice Application for each child to the Dansville School District.

Lottery

Due to the limited number of openings available in Dansville School District, all eligible applicants who have filed their School of Choice Application by the deadline date will be entered into a lottery. Names will be drawn randomly and admitted in the order drawn.

If more students apply than the minimum number posted above, students will be placed on a waitlist in the order drawn. If additional openings become available, students will be accepted in order from the waitlist. Applicants are welcome, but not required to attend the lottery drawing. All applicants will be notified of lottery results following the drawing.

Enrollment

Students drawn to enroll in Dansville School District through the lottery will complete the online enrollment process immediately following the lottery drawing.

Once a student is enrolled and continuously attends Dansville School District through school of choice, that student is entitled to continue to attend school in Dansville until graduation without having to reapply for school of choice.

Code of Conduct

All Student Code of Conduct rules, procedures, and policies will apply to all students who enter Dansville School District under the school of choice.
