- M-STEP testing has been completed for all students 3rd-4th grades.
- FAST Bridge screenings have been completed for this spring. This is our third screening of the year which collects data on reading growth.
- Our beloved Jan Baker is retiring from her Office Paraprofessional position. She was celebrated on Wednesday, May 19th along with last year's retirees: Michele Momberg, Dave Klingbiel and Sandy Hunt.
- Training has recently begun once again related to the Kindergarten Readiness
 Assessment mandated by the state. This assessment will measure incoming
 Kindergarten students' abilities across 4 domains: literacy, math, physical and
 social/emotional readiness. This assessment first began in 19-20, then was paused
 for this year due to COVID. It will resume for next year's Begindergarten and
 Kindergarten students.
- In partnering with the Dansville Library, library cards were sent home for all elementary students that provided information on the many resources the public library has available for them.
- Aggie Academy will provide instruction for K-5 students from June 2-30 on Mondays-Thursdays from 8:30-11:30. Free breakfast, lunch and busing is provided this year. As of right now, we have 54 students signed up.
- Ms. Krejcik has put a lot of planning into this year's version of our annual Field Day experience. Wednesday, May 19th was the lower elementary Field Day and Thursday, May 20th for the upper elementary, 8:30-10:30.
