- Dansville High School's Seniors participated in College Application Week through the Michigan College Access Network. Heather Lloyd organized the event in which our students filled out college applications.
- Dansville High School's Freshmen participated in the annual Commitment to Graduate ceremony where they
 pledge their commitment to finish high school and earn a diploma. Vance DeCamp was this year's speaker and
 he spoke to the kids about the importance of achieving goals despite obstacles.
- This year 57% of our students were represented at the high school Parent-Teacher Conferences. At the middle school, we had 74% represented, which is average for fall conferences.
- Dansville High School Marching Band members, Megan Ahlers (tuba) and Sylvia Grice (trumpet) were selected to participate in the Grand Valley State University Honors Marching Band. They joined 100 other marching band students from around the state for this special event.
- Preston Graf was honored by the Williamston Sunrise Rotary Club as the Dansville Student of the Quarter for his outstanding achievement and leadership in school activities.
- Dansville High School students in American Literature classes honored Veterans with a special assembly and luncheon. The classes invited area Veterans to attend and had Veteran Sarah Ruddle from Torch 180 provide a special message.
- Members of Dansville's FFA traveled to the FFA National Convention in Indianapolis. Students had an
