High School Board Report



Band: The High School Symphonic Band received a Division 1, Superior rating at the 2025 MSBOA District 8 Band Festival- which is our first time receiving an overall Division 1 rating in over 15 years! The school was awarded with a plaque for the trophy case and individual medals for the students. This is an awesome accomplishment as we perform at the Okemos site each year, playing right before or after much larger Class A or B schools. A Division 1 rating is state qualifying- although we chose to forego State Band Festival as late April is a very busy time of year for the HS students.

At our Spring Concert on May 5, we gave out our annual Band Awards, earned for each year of dedicated participation to the ensemble. The 1st year members received their Letters, members completing their 2nd year received their instrument pins, 3rd year members received their year guard pins, and 6 of our Seniors earned their 'Dansville Music Award' plaques. The 2025 MSBOA High School Scholar Instrumentalist Award was awarded to Hannah Burnham; the 2025 Louis Armstrong Jazz Award was awarded to Theo Davis; and the 2025 John Philip Sousa Award was given to Carter Tkaczyk.
















Passion Hour: Mrs. Braman's ELA 11 classes put on some great presentations for Passion Hour this year! Our students have amazing passions and are very talented.
