- A big thank you to Stacy Hallock as she organized a Box Tops Dime Drive for our school. It was a one-week coin drive that the students participated in to potentially win a bonus recess for their class. The top 3 classes earning the reward were Mrs. Ream, Miss Ulch, and Mrs. Bush. We were all winners though as \$1715 was raised for our building. This money will be used for the ongoing support of PBIS prizes, materials/supplies that teachers may request, refreshing our playground ball supply, etc.
