- Superintendent Wonnell reported on the following items:
 - Facilities:
 - We are beginning to have conversations about moving fifth grade back into the elementary building.
 - Mr. Miller has also contacted a company to assist with catch basin vacuuming before the spring thaw/summer storm season.
 - It is time to revive the parking lot project. This project was put on hold back in 2022.
 - Safety: Representative Brixie and Commissioner Ruest have given an update on the M-36 project. A
 flashing light for the pedestrian crossing looks promising, but a study needs to be done to determine the
 right device for the situation.
 - Attitude of Gratitude:
 - We are grateful to Sydney Hammerstein and Michelle Redman and our Middle School Student Council who helped decorate downtown for the holidays.
 - We are proud of Anna McDaniel who signed to play volleyball with Concordia next year.
 - Dansville Schools was able to assist 20 families with a Thanksgiving meal, and 23 families for Christmas.
 - WLNS/WLAJ featured the Equestrian Team under their "Extraordinary Student." It will air sometime
 this month.
