- Superintendent Wonnell reported on the following items:
 - **State Testing:** Adding another assessment – NWEA for 3rd–12th grade students; happens three times a year; immediate feedback to students and teachers.
 - **Summer School:** Planning is underway; invitations are on the way.
 - **Community Day:** Students like the cross-age interactions with other students; give back to community and gives them a break from classroom.
 - **Student Support:** An additional student support position will be added this fall.
 - **Gratitude:** Thank you to the Ladybugs for donating \$500 towards Many Hands and \$500 for the Washington DC trip. Kudos to Mrs. St Amant for a wonderful play; a lighted Aggie head was donated from a community member; apprenticeship wall is being donated from a local labor union; GSRP will be adding two more spots next fall!
