## Administrative work:

Our team worked together to complete the Program Evaluation Tool, the District Improvement Plan and the Elementary, Middle and HS School Improvement Plans. We incorporated the research and work we did throughout the entire year related to MTSS.

## Athletics:

We are pleased to announce we have hired Rashonda Schild as our new Varsity Volleyball coach this week. She has previous school and club volleyball experience and enthusiasm to build the program. We are still looking to finalize a cheer coach for fall and will be posting the Varsity Softball position next week.

## Budget Info:

We have started recording changes for Revision l of the budget based on actual hiring and other changes that we will learn over the next several months, including enrollment numbers. We are currently anticipating more students than was budgeted. We have already enrolled several new students over the past month.

## Communication:

The Winter/Spring/Summer newsletter was distributed to the community since the last board meeting.

Registration Day will take place on Tuesday, August $2 I^{\text {st }}$. Packets will start to be distributed next week via pick up at our office.

## Community Outreach/Partnerships:

## Curriculum/Training:

We sent Jerrod Braman to AP Computer Science training that was provided by code.org and he has shared very positive feedback regarding his experience and the impact this course will have on students and our school.

## Data:

We have not received any data from M-STEP but we have received some PSAT and SAT data we have started to examine. The scores have not been released in aggregate, so we are only able to look at individual scores.

## Facilities:

New construction and renovation work continues throughout the entire district. Several areas are getting finishes at this point. The focus is on instructional spaces. The Board will have the chance to tour the project on Monday again. Please let me know if you are not able to attend.

## Personnel Update:

We are very excited to share that we have hired Andrea Salinas as our new fifth grade teacher. She is already an Aggie parent of a ${ }^{\text {st }}$ grader and she comes to us with 14 years of experience in Grand Ledge. She will be a strong addition to the fifth grade team!
