- M-STEP schedules and accommodations are being prepared. Nearly all of the elementary standardized tests will take place from April 11-29.
- Kindergarten and Begindergarten Round Up took place on Feb. 23rd. It's always an exciting event to see the energy, enthusiasm in the form of future Aggies. At this point we have about 40 students registered. This does not take into account the current Begindergarten students who will return next year as Kindergarten students.

We have enjoyed mystery guest readers and other exciting activities including a Beach READ-IN where we are transforming the gym into a beach scene.
