

Dansville Elementary School June Board Update

- We have 61 elementary students attending Aggie Academy this summer to expand their literacy and math skills. They have been meeting four days per week for three hours at a time. Once again this year, we have partnered with Dansville CADL and students have been able to visit the library twice throughout the program. The last day of Aggie Academy is on Thursday, June 26. This year, CADL also utilized our performance area for various performers. Aggie Academy students and the public were in attendance for these fun events!
- Interviews have taken place for the K-8 basic technology teacher position.
- All paraprofessionals plan to return in the fall making it the first summer in several years that we have not had open paraprofessional positions!
- There were 0 documented incidents of bullying during the 2024-2025 school year. By the standards of the Olweus Bullying Prevention Program, bullying is when someone *repeatedly and intentionally* says or does mean or hurtful things to another person who has a hard time defending himself or herself. Our data indicates that students struggle much more with reacting to frustrating situations in anger resulting in a physical aggression label (pushes or hits another student when things don't go their way). Behavioral issues related to physical aggression are handled with phone calls home to the parents always as well as an appropriate consequence here at school such as: missed recess, another missed privilege, written apologies, after-school detention, Saturday School, in-school suspension, or a combination of these consequences.
