Hello, Board Members,

One month of school "under our belts" already!

As we all wait anxiously to see if the State finalizes the budget before October 1<sup>st</sup>, School Nutrition Staff/Administrations around the state hold our breaths for positive news that the All-Free Meals Program will continue. Most of my staff only know free meals, but we CAN and will make the necessary changes and training to switch back to financial-based meal accounting if necessary.

Most of my staff and myself attended the CPR Training conducted by the Dansville Fire Department this past August that was presented to teachers and support staff. I plan to finish up the remaining required 6 hours of annual training this coming half day with instruction on reimbursable meals, Civil Rights Training and meal counting. I myself still have several hours to fill to reach my required 20 hours, so I plan to attend 2 classes presented by SNAM (School Nutrition Association of Michigan) on portion control, correct measuring and correct production record keeping as well as another class on conflict resolution, which unfortunately, always seems to creep into our daily routine.

Dansville Schools has been selected as one of the many schools to receive the Administrative Review this school year, done by Michigan Department of Education; Child Nutrition Department. I had some training yesterday with my auditor, and we wait for GEMS/MARS to open up with more training and the online Preassessment form. I do not know yet when my audit will take place, but I have requested April.
